Nassau County Police Department Safety Tips **During the High Holy Days**



Thefts from Vehicles

- Park in well-lit areas.
- LOCK YOUR VEHICLE and do not leave it running unattended.
- Do not leave a GPS or any other valuables visible in the vehicle. Hide packages and shopping bags in the trunk.
- Keep keys in your hand when walking to your car or home.

Burglary Prevention

- If you have an alarm, be sure to set it. Consider installing an alarm system, if you don't have one.
- Gifts and valuables should be kept out of sight, away from windows.
- Do not publicize that you will be out of town on the internet.
- Leave your lights on when you leave the house.
- Lock all doors and windows when you leave, even if it's just for a few minutes.
- Ask a neighbor to watch your home if you'll be away.
- Never open the door for someone you do not know. Always verify employment ID before allowing entry into your home.

Take Inventory

- Make time to update or create a home inventory.
- Take photos or make a video of valuable items with descriptions and serial numbers
